The main barriers assigned by nurses caring for patients at the end of life were angry family members, inadequate understanding of nursing care by the patient's relatives; lack of time to talk to patients, lack of nursing knowledge to deal with the bereaved patient's family, lack of evaluation of nurses' opinions, and the evasion by physicians to talk about the diagnosis and their over-optimistic view of the situation.

Preparing an End of Life Care Plan: Nurses Should Lead the ...

Medical advances often prolong and medicalise the dying process, increasing patients' dependency on palliative and end-of-life care. This means that, on top of other NHS pressures, health professionals - and nurses, in particular - are increasingly charged with managing death and dying for patients in their care.

Providing Care and Comfort at the End of Life | National ...

Nurses caring for patients at the end of life have a moral and professional obligation to follow the guidelines depicted in their professional and ethical standards. The absence of an advance directive can make end of life decision-making difficult for families of dying patients who are no longer able to speak for themselves.

Identify resources within themselves to deal with situation. Visit regularly and participate positively in care of patient, within limits of abilities. Express more realistic understanding and expectations of patient. Provide opportunity for patient to deal with situation in own way.

Nurses are obliged to provide comprehensive and compassionate end-of-life care. This includes recognizing when death is near and conveying that information to families. Nurses should collaborate with other members of the health care team to ensure optimal symptom management and to provide support for the patient and family.
