(TFT) thyroid scan test in which a radioactive iodine is administered that localizes in the thyroid gland. the gland can then be visualized with a scanning device to detect pathology such as tumors thyroid storm thyrotoxic crisis; result of major infection/sepsis or surgery; caused by increased thyroid hormone; symptoms are tachycardia, agitation, coma, hypotension - could lead to death; treated with iodine, PTU, beta blocker for tachycardia, cooling, sedation, glucocorticoids to decrease ...

Calcium, produces PTH which is a peptide, controls the metabolism of calcium, embedded in back of thyroid gland, controls metabolism of calcium, stimulate osteoclasts to remove calcium from bones (like scrubbing bubbles), raise calcium levels in blood, stimulate kidney and intestine to absorb more calcium.
