The Passive House standard requires a peak heating load of no more than 3.17 Btu/hr per sq. ft. The energy savings that would flow from hitting this target are too low to justify the extremely high cost of the insulation needed to achieve it.

How well a particular insulation works is expressed by the R-value, which ranges from 2.0 to 8.0 per inch of insulation. The higher the R-value, the better job the insulation does at preventing the transfer of heat. Fiberglass and cellulose insulation have R-values of 2.9 to 3.8 per inch while sprayed foam insulation can go as high as 8.0 per inch.

The amount of insulation recommended for your home is dependent on where you live, but here are some general guidelines: Attic Insulation: Houses in a cold climate should have a minimum of R-49 in the attic, which is equivalent to approximately 16" of fiberglass insulation. Warmer climates only require an R-38 or higher, or about 12" or more.

The amount of insulation recommended for your home will vary depending on a number of factors: Where you live—Different climates require different insulation R-values. You will need a higher R-value of insulation if you live in the Northeast than if you live in Southern California.

R-values range from 2.2 to 3.8 per inch, depending on the material. For example, in a 3 1/2-inch wall cavity, filling the walls with loose-fill insulation can add an R-value of 7.7 to 13.3 to whatever insulating value is already present in the sheathing, siding, and drywall.

Use the insulation calculator to plug in your ZIP code, lifestyle factors, building design, energy costs and budget to get a detailed recommendation. The recommended ceiling insulation level for most attics is R-38 (or about 12 to 15 in. from the drywall, depending on the insulation type).

Attic Insulation | How Much Do I Need?

Insulation levels are specified by R-Value. R-Value is a measure of insulation's ability to resist heat flow. The higher the R-Value, the better the thermal performance of the insulation. The recommended level for most attics is to insulate to R-38 or about 10 to 14 inches, depending on insulation type.

To find out if you have enough insulation in your attic, measure the thickness of the insulation from top to bottom using a ruler. If it is less than R-30 (which is to say, 11 inches of fiber glass/rock wool or 8 inches of cellulose) then you may want to add more. If the joists are 10 inches deep, the cavity can take high-density R-30 insulation, which is 8 1/2 inches thick, more than enough for floor insulation.
