What is Accreditation of Senior Living Communities ...

To earn and maintain accreditation, a long term care organization must undergo an on-site survey by a Joint Commission surveyor(s) approximately every three years. The objective of the survey is not only to evaluate the long term care organization, but to provide education and guidance that will help s taff continue to improve its performance.

Long Term Care Accreditation Survey

Ontario Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care recognizes CARF accreditation for

long-term care homes and provides a funding premium to accredited homes. Ontario's Community Care Access Centres (CCACs) recognize CARF Canada as a choice for accreditation of both CCACs and contracted service providers.

Accreditation Options and Certifications for Nursing Care ...

Nursing home surveys are conducted in accordance with survey protocols and Federal requirements to determine whether a citation of non-compliance appropriate. Consolidated Medicare and Medicaid requirements for participation (requirements) for Long Term Care (LTC) facilities (42 CFR part 483, subpart B) were first published in the Federal Register on February 2, 1989 (54 FR 5316).

Survey Preparedness - The MU Long Term Care Leadership Coaches recommend that your home maintain a SURVEY BOOK. The purpose of the book is to help your staff be survey ready every day. To be ready for the annual visit, the SURVEY BOOK should be reviewed weekly so that it is kept up-to- date.
