Sections 22.3.4.2 and 23.3.4.2 of NFPA 101 require fire alarms to initiate manually, as well as by any detection devices that may be required in other parts of the code. ### **NFPA 96: Standard for Ventilation Control and Fire ...**

Manual activation is commonly accomplished using a manual fire pull, and automatic detection happens without human intervention. NFPA 72, also called the National Fire Alarm Code (NFAC), is the primary document used when an engineer designs, and an EC or fire alarm technician installs, a fire alarm system.

### **SECTION 907 FIRE ALARM AND DETECTION SYSTEMS**

These requirements are provided in NFPA 72 National Fire Alarm and Signaling Code, which guides the design and installation of fire alarm systems, including fire alarm pull stations. NFPA 72 refers to fire alarm pull stations as “manual fire alarm boxes.”. The code requires that the travel distance to the nearest pull station on a given floor must be no more than 200 feet.

### **Fire Alarm Requirements for Group E Occupancy | Fire ...**

9.6.1.4 To ensure operational integrity, the fire alarm system shall have an approved maintenance and testing program complying with the applicable requirements of NFPA 70 and NFPA 72. The International Fire Code uses the following verbiage, which like NFPA 72 and NFPA 1, places the responsibility of inspection and testing upon the building owner:

NFPA develops, publishes, and disseminates more than 300 consensus codes and standards intended to minimize the possibility and effects of fire and other risks. Virtually every building, process, service, design, and installation in society today is affected by NFPA documents.

### **Nfpa Code Requiring Manual Pull Station**

GroupE: (Education) Systems required to be monitored per the 2015 IFC section 907.6.6. A manual fire alarm system (pull stations) that activates an emergency voice/alarm communication system (speakers, mass notification) shall be installed.

### **What are the Requirements for a Fire Alarm Pull Station?**

Manual Pull Station Requirements (as per NFPA 72) The requirements for manual pull stations as per NFPA 72 are pretty trivial and straight-forward. NFPA 72 requires that manual pull stations be installed within 60 inches of the exit doorway of each exit, mounted between 42 inches and 48 inches to the center of the handle, and, among other things, be red in color.

Note that these requirements only apply to doors that lock or latch. They do not apply if a door has push/pull hardware and no lock or latch. In facilities that are required to follow NFPA 101 - Life Safety Code, there are four occupancy classifications where panic hardware is required: 1.

2. The manual fire alarm box is not required for Group R-2 occupancies unless required by the fire code official to provide a means for fire watch personnel to initiate an alarm during a sprinkler system impairment event. Where provided, the manual fire alarm box shall not be located in an area that is accessible to the public.
