The literature of this era was partly new and partly a continuance of that of the Restoration. This age may be divided into two periods: the first stretching from 1700 to 1750 in the neo-classic Age, and the second, the transitional period which spans from 1750 to 1798.

English Literature: THE AUGUSTAN AGE

Satire had already been a feature of Restoration literature, prior to the Augustan era, but at that time it was more circumscribed due to threat of prosecution for defamation. In the eighteenth century, satire and parody were more widely used across the spectrum of prose, poetry and dramatic works.
